Subject: Reopening of Schools | Covid-19 SOP requirements from Parents

Dear Parents,

Asalam o Aleikum Wa Rahmatullahe Wa Barakatohu,

We hope that you and all your family members are in good health.

As attending school physically has its own value and cannot be replaced. During the closedown period, NPS made sure that the learning of our students continued via NPS E-Connect.

Finally, it is time to return to school as the Government of Sindh announces the re-opening of the educational institutions. Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) have been prescribed by the authorities to minimize the spread of Covid-19, stipulating the responsibilities of different stakeholders.

As we gear ourselves up for welcoming our students and staff back to school, we would like to share with you the requirements outlined by the Govt. of Sindh to be ensured by the parents, while the school management, teaching / non-teaching staff and students comply with their own set of requirements.

- The parents being the primary caregivers must ensure that their children are taking the necessary precautions. Explain to your child what is happening in simple words and reassure them that they are safe.
- Model and teach your children to cover mouth while coughing and sneezing with bent/flexed elbow or tissue and dispose-off the used tissue immediately. Hands should be washed immediately, afterwards or use hand sanitizers.
- Children will be required to wear a mask to attend school.
- Parents are advised not to send their children to schools in case they display any symptom of COVID-19 which include fever, coughing, sneezing and shortness of breath or if someone else in the family is tested positive and is not in full quarantine.
- In case of not attending the school due to the above-stated reasons, notify the school and request for home assignments so that students can continue learning while at home.
- Parents will be responsible for the safe transportation of their children to school.
- Parents must ensure that they or the van drivers wait near the school gate till the students are allowed entry into the school after screening for body temperature. In case a child is identified with increased body temperature (above 99.5 °F), the van driver will be required to take the child back home, immediately.
- Parents must ensure to send packed snacks and water bottles with their children. The school canteen will remain closed.
- Parents must ensure to send stationery items, books and other necessary belongings with their children. Students will not be allowed to share their belongings so they must bring all their required items each day.

Nasra Public School is committed to providing a safe and conducive learning environment for our students. Together, we can ensure the continuity of their learning in academics, as well as the development of the other social skills.
